



## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **WAKATIPU SBS DINGHY REGATTA Lake Wakatipu Queenstown**

The Organising Authority is Wakatipu Yacht Club Inc. Box 182 Queenstown

**Saturday and Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> January 2010**

#### **1. Rules**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 - 2012
- 1.2 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply. Notwithstanding the dispensation granted by Yachting New Zealand, sailboard competitors shall comply with clause 1.
- 1.3 The Organising Authority may require all participating boats to display advertising in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.3.(d).

#### **2. Changes to Racing Rules**

- 2.1 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.
- 2.2 Rule 61.1(a) will be changed for the P class so that a protest flag will be required.

#### **3. Changes to Class Rules**

#### **4. Eligibility and Entry**

- 4.1 The regatta is open to boats of the following classes: Class starts will be offered if more than 5 boats of 1 class start.
  - Optimist Green Fleet
  - Optimist Open
  - P Class
  - Starling
  - Laser Full, Radial, 4.7
  - Sunburst
  - 29er
  - R Class
  - Multihull's
  - Open Other

- 4.2 Other classes may enter provided a minimum of 5 entries are received prior to the warning signal of race 1.
- 4.3 Entries accompanied by the entry fee as set out below will be accepted at Wakatipu Club until 09.45 hours on race day. The following documents must be submitted with the entry.
- proof of yacht club membership
  - proof of date of birth.

### **5. Schedule of Events**

- 5.1 Saturday  
0900 Registration
- 0945 Briefing
- 1045 Racing starts - 5 races
- Sunday  
1000 Racing starts – 4 Races

- 5.2 A Total of 9 races for each class are scheduled.
- 5.3 Prize giving Sunday as soon as possible after racing has concluded

### **6. Sailing Instructions**

- 6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available from the Wakatipu Yacht Club Queenstown at registration.

### **7. Racing Area**

- 7.1 The races will be held on the waters of Lake Wakatipu.

### **8. Courses to be Sailed**

- 8.1 The course(s) will be Trapezoid, Windward / Leeward or Triangular.

### **9. Scoring**

- 9.1 Low points scoring system will apply.
- 9.2 One or more races will be required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 When from six to eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 9.4 When nine races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

### **10. Alternative Penalties**

- 10.1 For the Multihull classes rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.
- 10.2 Appendix P will apply.

**11. Prizes**

The following prizes will be awarded:

Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in each class, provided there are 5 or more boats in the class competing.

**12. Team Support Boats**

12.1 Support boats will be allowed.

12.2 Support boats must be registered with the Organising Authority at registration (clause 5.2 above).

**13. Launching and retrieving**

13.1 All boats will be required to launch and retrieve from Wakatipu Yacht Club, Queenstown.

**14. Substitution of crews**

14.1 Substitution of crews will not be allowed without prior written approval of the protest committee, and then only in exceptional circumstances.

**15. Results and Regatta Information**

15.1 Results and further information will be available on the Wakatipu Yacht Club website, [www.wakatipuyachtclub.co.nz](http://www.wakatipuyachtclub.co.nz).

**17. Disclaimer of Liability**
